Getting Started

Scan the QR code above. You will be taken to the APPLE APP STORE or the GOOGLE PLAY STORE, depending on what kind of phone or device you have.

Download the app.

The app is completely free, and you will not be charged any money.

Opening the App

Tap on the app and "allow" Ride Pingo to send you notifications.

Tap "Get Started" and fill out your details.

When prompted to enter your phone number remember to change the first two digits to +44 and take off the first 0.

Verify and Go

You will then be sent a code by text message to enter into Pingo.

Please note that your details are encrypted and will be safe and secure.

Allow Ride Pingo to access your location whilst using the app.

That's it, you're all set! You can now explore the app and enter where you currently are and where you would like to go. East Lothian's new on-demand bus service, offering flexible travel that works around YOU!











It operates within the East Lothian area and is perfect for joining up journeys, integrating with the existing transport network, and providing bus travel where a service doesn't exist.




By simply downloading the "Ride Pingo" app you can book your journey quickly and easily, and track the progress of your bus as it makes its way to your assigned pick-up point.
